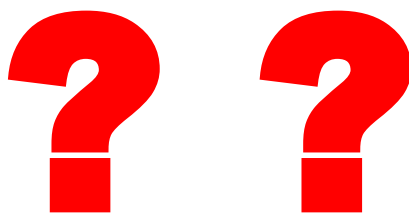

OR: you are welcome to come to the church at any time between 1:30pm and 4:30pm on a Monday, just to see what is happening, and join in.

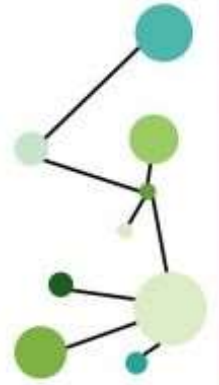

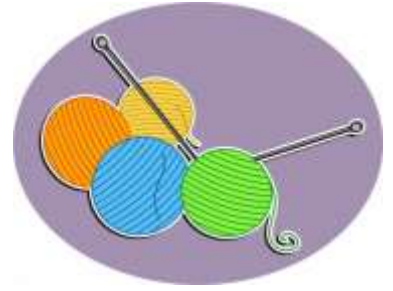
An impressive speaker from the *Childhood Foundation* Angela Weller will speak about Transforming the lives of Children.
