Time out to prepare ourselves as we journey to the manger through quiet moments to reflect on meditations offered during this time.

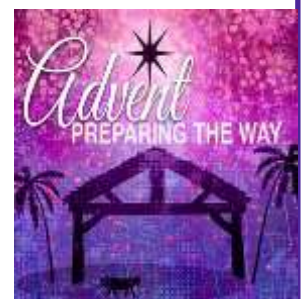
