

#### St Bartholomew, Apostle and Martyr

He was thus named by the Synoptic Gospels (the name means 'son of Tolmai'), but the Fourth Gospel speaks of Nathanael, not Bartholomew. The two are generally identified [as one and the same] by present-day scholars. Nothing is known for certain about the place of his apostolate or even his death. Pantenus of Alexandria is said by Eusebius to have found in 'India' during the second half of the 2nd century a Gospel of St Matthew, written in Hebrew and left behind by Bartholomew. The Roman Martyrology attributes to him an apostolate in India and Armenia, where he was said to have been flayed alive before being beheaded, the place being traditionally Derbend, on the Caspian sea. The method of his martyrdom appealed to the imagination of artists; his most usual emblem is the flaying-knife. By association with his own fate, he is regarded as the patron saint of tanners and all who work at skins. The Church remembers Bartholomew, apostle and martyr, on the 24th August.
