Our first Taizé service will be held on April 6th 2025 at 5pm in the Old Church. What is Taizé? It is a Christian service characterized by the repetitive singing of simple tunes, interspersed with bible readings, prayers and periods of silence.

It was founded by Brother Roger Schütz in the village of Taizé, France in 1940 and is open to people of all denominations. The simple, meditative form of Taizé worship calls us to dwell deeply on **Christ's presence around and within us.**

Please consider Taizé as a further enrichment to your spiritual life.
